CALLED TO SERVE - OPPORTUNITY

The need is urgent. Please help our community.

We are called to serve. One of our opportunities to serve is coming up this Sunday. Our community has a constant challenge to serve those who are hungry or are food insecure. At this time the need is significantly greater than in the past. The economy of our community has been hit hard by the need to stay at home due to COVID 19 and the resulting loss of jobs. Please plan to help our neighbors by participating in the upcoming food drive for ABCCM (Asheville Buncombe Community Christian Ministry). Your donation of food, supplies, or cash/check will be collected from your vehicle. You do not need to get out of the vehicle. **Plan to stay in your vehicle the entire time.** We cannot have more than 10 people onsite at any one time.

How will the food be collected: This will be a drive-by style donation at our Fellowship Center (across the street from the actual church). Church volunteers will be ready to receive your donations for delivery to ABCCM.

Top Items Needed: toilet paper , canned chicken, vegetable oil, sugar, laundry detergent, store-bought eggs, cash/check (ABCCM can purchase food at a significant discount. Checks make payable to Weaverville United Methodist Church and indicate this is for ABCCM.)


Ongoing Needs: peanut butter, jelly, grits packets, oatmeal packets, hot dogs, canned tuna, spaghetti sauce, bags of potatoes, bags of onions, sandwich bread (they stay good beyond date), dish detergent, hearty soups, dry milk, grits, self rising flour, cornmeal, canned or dry beans, rice

While you are dropping off items you can also:

- **Pick up a church directory!** The church directories have arrived and are ready for distribution to all who had their pictures taken. While you are making your donation tell the volunteer you would like to pick up your directory.

- **Pick up an Upper Room devotion guide**. Let the volunteer know if you would like to pick up a devotion guide and we will hand a copy to you.

- **Drop off your church tithe or donation**. Please give to the volunteer as you come through the drop off process. Many of our expenses continue even though we are not meeting together.
