LOCAL FAMILY IN NEED

This is a note from Steve Tensi, one of our church members: As some may know, I am a fire adjuster with a large insurance company. On the day before Christmas, I traveled to Shelby, NC to look at a completely destroyed home. This home was a rental house, and our company insured the owner of the house. The cause of fire appears to be electrical in nature, and there was only the shell of the house left at the time of my inspection.

The owner of the house will be fully compensated from his insurance policy for the loss of the structure. But during my inspection, I met the mother of the family that had been renting the house and she explained they were woken up by the fire at 4:30am that morning and rushed out of the burning house. Wife and her husband and 5 boys in the family (19,17,14, and twins of 12 years old). Thankfully, all family members got out basically unhurt, but they did lose the two family dogs in the fire, as well as all their belongings. Very modest family, both parents work, lost everything they ever owned in the world. They had no insurance on any of their belongings.....It was heartbreaking, and all I could do for her was tell her I would pray for her family (which I did as I left the property).

I've been doing this job for 30+ years and seen many sad circumstances, but this one really hit home, possibly even more so as it was the day before Christmas. I'm going to be giving the family some money from the Tensi's, and just wondered if anyone else at the church might like to join in. I will only be waiting until this Thursday (Jan. 9) as the need is great.
