# AN ORDER FOR THE CELEBRATION OF AN APPOINTMENT OF A PASTOR

<u>Leader</u>: Dear friends, today we welcome *Pastor Richard Blount*, who has been appointed to serve as our pastor. We believe that he is well qualified and has been prayerfully appointed by our Bishop.

<u>Leader to pastor</u>: *Pastor Richard Blount*, you have been sent to live among us as a bearer of the Word of God; a minister of the Sacraments; and a sustainer of the love, order, and discipleship of the people of God.

<u>Pastor</u>: Today I reaffirm this commitment in the presence of this congregation.

Leader to congregation: Brothers and sisters in Christ, as a people committed to participate in the ministries of the Church by your prayers, your presence, your gifts, your service, and your witness, will you who celebrate this new beginning support and uphold *Pastor Richard Blount*, in these ministries?

<u>Congregation</u>: We reaffirm our commitment to support you with our prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness.

Leader: How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of the messenger;

<u>Congregation</u>: who announces peace, who brings good news, who announces salvation.
