From the Trustees:

Last summer, while preparing for the arrival of the Blount family, and after an insp by a licensed home inspector, we discovered a number of significant problems parsonage required corrections. Some of these problems were both urgen expensive, such as a new electrical service, upgrade of the upstairs heating a system, and replacement of the sewer drain pipe from the house to the street. projects, along with a number of others, have been accomplished.

We are blessed because the Trustees have access to dedicated, reserved fun maintenance purposes. We have been able to pay for all the needed work as completed, a total of approximately \$44,000. Now we have a final major issue that to be addressed, and we are asking for help from the congregation. The roof parsonage and the roof on the detached garage need to be replaced. We have a experienced a leak at the parsonage that required temporary patching.

We have solicited three proposals to replace both roofs from reputable, licensed r contractors. Both projects can be done for approximately \$13,000. The num approximate because there may be hidden damage to the wooden roof deck itse those unknown repairs could affect the final figure.

Any non-expired car seats or boosters for car. Gently used/outgrown clothing & equipment always appreciated.




Six Week Women's Bible Study


