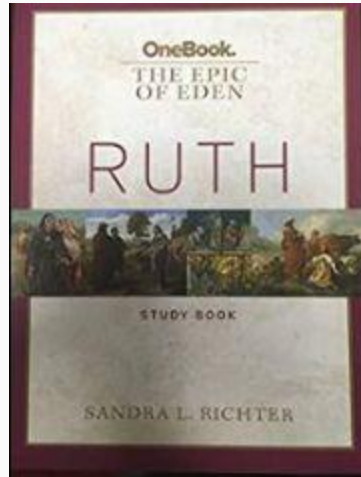

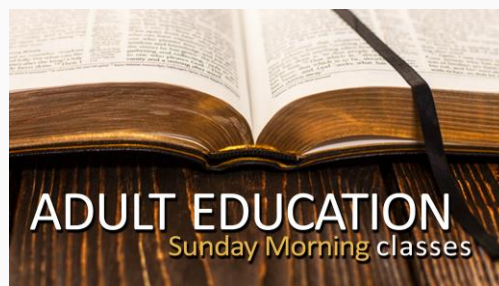

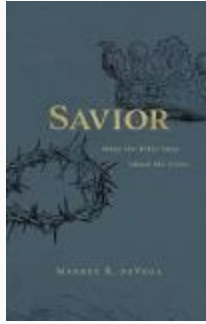
Six Week Women's Bible Study
