There will be no Sunday School Classes this Sunday since Youth and Children will be using that time to rehearse for Youth Sunday at the 11 o'clock service


We will be continuing our Confirmation Study this Sunday! We will meet from 4-5:30pm in the Fellowship Hall's Main Room






Six Week Women's Bible Study


