in the Fellowship Hall's Main Room


We will not have any Youth or Children's activities on Mother's Day (May 14) or Memorial Day Weekend (May 28)

Every bit of food we collect is distributed through the **North ABCCM** pantry.


All money donated with the notation **ABCCM North** is used to purchase food for the North Buncombe pantry only.






