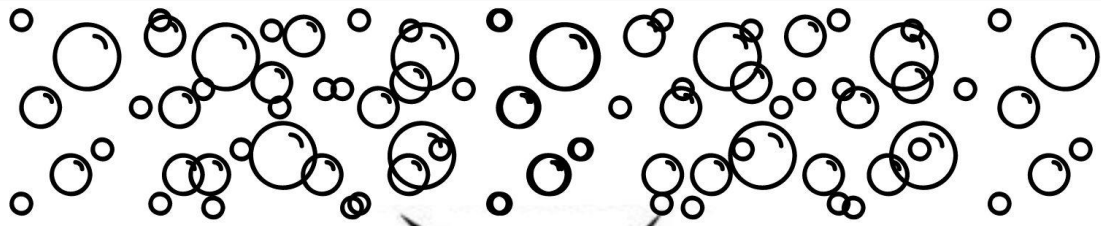

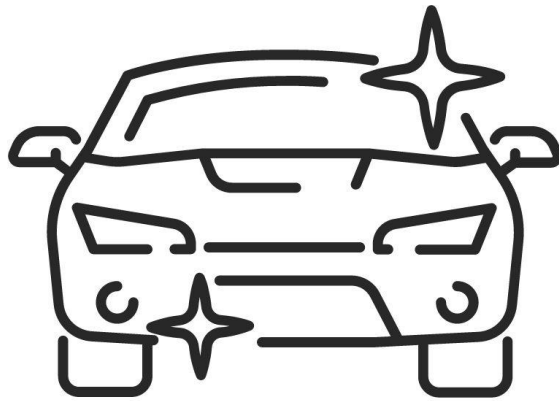
Come for Fellowship



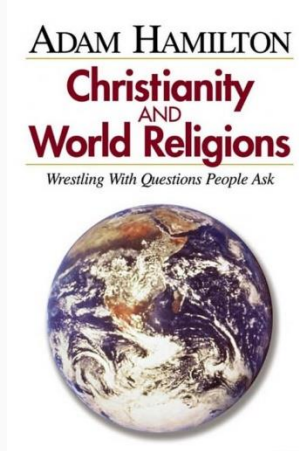

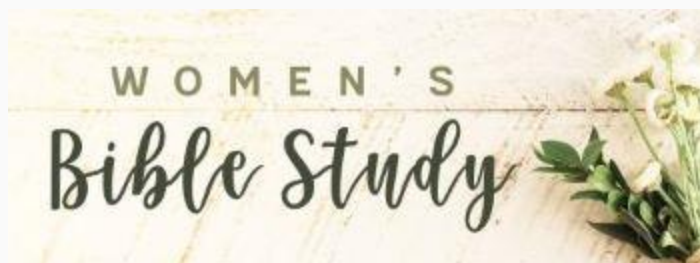
