Please make out any checks to **ABCCM North**



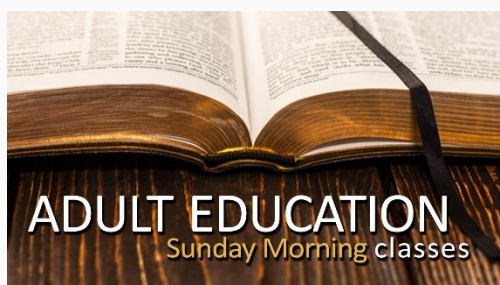
Administrative Council

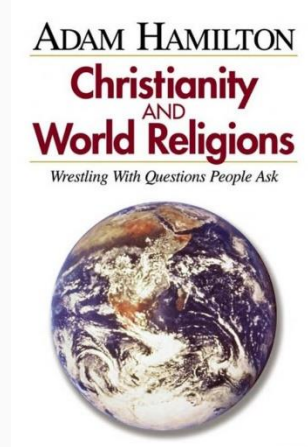

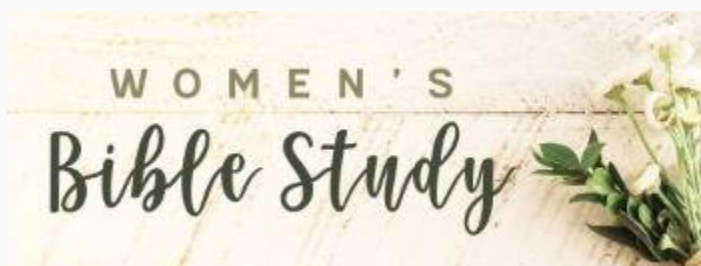
