


WUMC Newsletter 8/10/2023

Safety and security when using church facilities is an important consideration. Anyone who is involved in activities in our church buildings should accept they have a role to play in protecting church assets and the

safety of others who may be in the building at that time or in the future. Energy conservation is also important. The needs are really very simple. If you use a facility please make sure all entrances are secure before the last person leaves. Doors can be easily locked, but if you have any questions about how this is done contact Steve VanReenan for advice. Also, please turn off all interior lights when the last person leaves. We have some great facilities, and each of us must accept our responsibilities for protecting them.

Finally, our buildings have designated fire/emergency exits. Please ensure these exits are not blocked or obstructed in any way. Recently an entire rack of folding chairs was discovered left in a position that totally blocked a rear exit for the Fellowship Center. This is potentially a dangerous situation. And, yes, the Fire Marshal does visit us on a regular basis. He has warned us on previous visits about this problem, and we wouldn't want to have a repeat of the problem on his next visit.




Support our Students



Administrative Council




