
We will be selling:





Can we be a part of his solution right here where hunger and lack of resources also affects His children and ultimately our entire community? This answer is hard to deny!




Oatmeal and grits packets or boxes, hearty soups, boxed milks, Chef Boyardee, Bags of produce, adult cereal.


