
Please join the **United Women in Faith** by donating any gently used blankets. WOMEN'S coats, gloves and hats are also appreciated!

We must pray, put our faith and trust in God, that His will brings forth the best outcome.


Can we be a part of his solution right here where hunger and lack of resources also affects His children and ultimately our entire community? This answer is hard to deny!






Explorers Class
