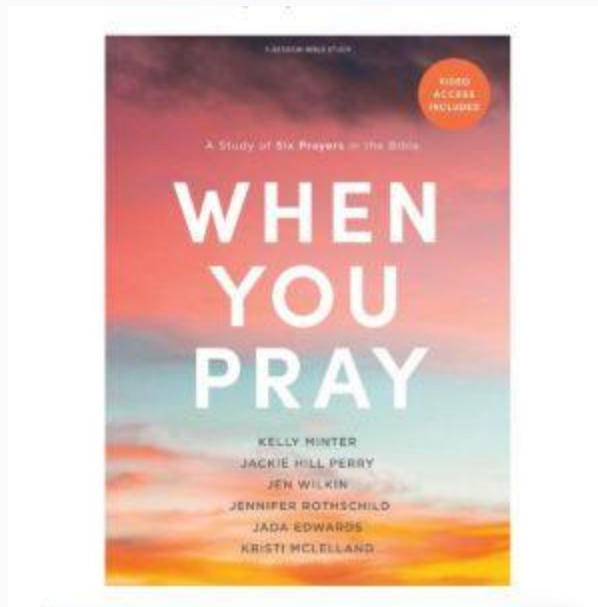


Explorers Class
