**VOLUNTEERS NEEDED:** Help with afternoon pickup from 4:45-7pm on the first Monday of the month on an occasional or regular basis.




Food Pantry list: vegetable oil (large containers are broken down), adult cereal, canned chicken and tuna, oatmeal and grits, corn meal.






# **Explorers Class**


