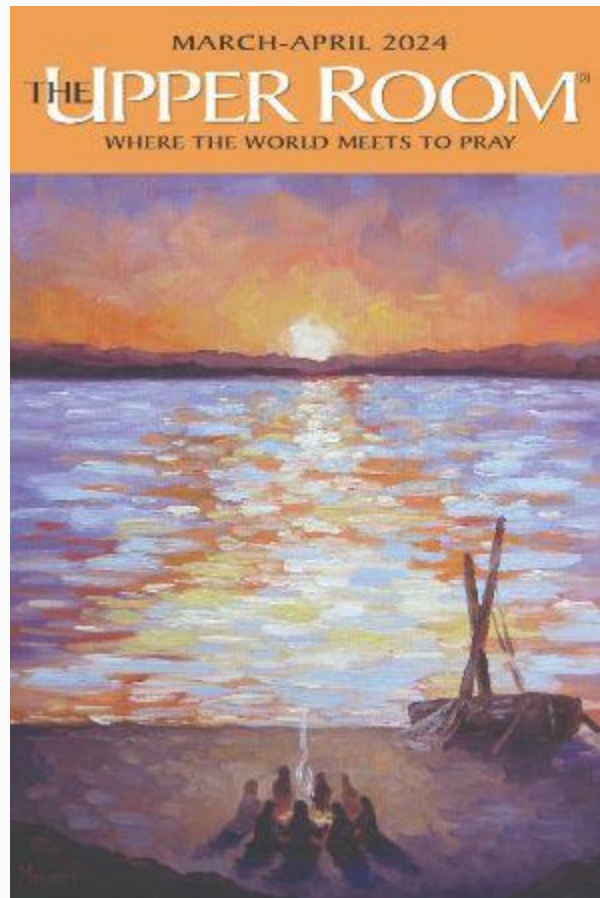
Come celebrate St. Patrick's Day with your church family at a pancake supper immediately following the March 17th Church Service. Wear your green!"

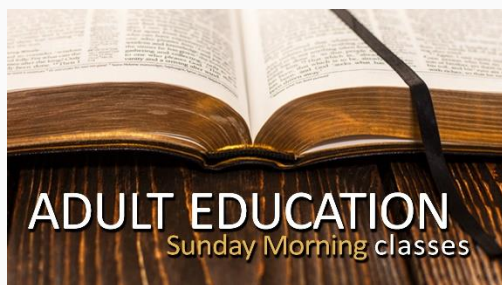

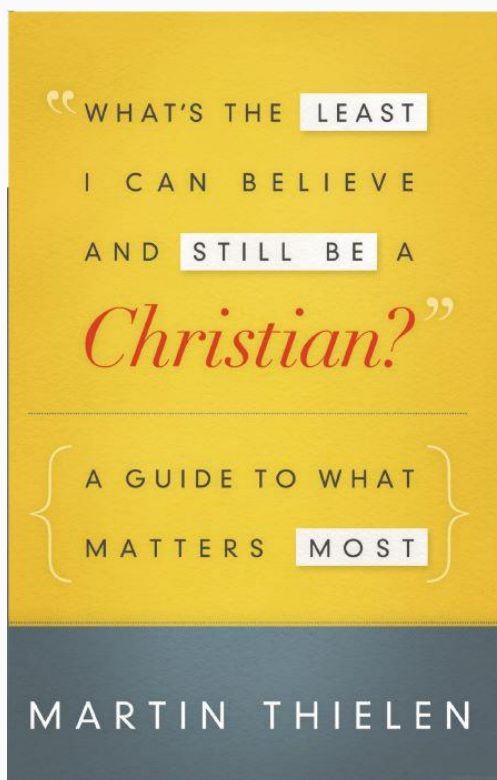

Explorers Class



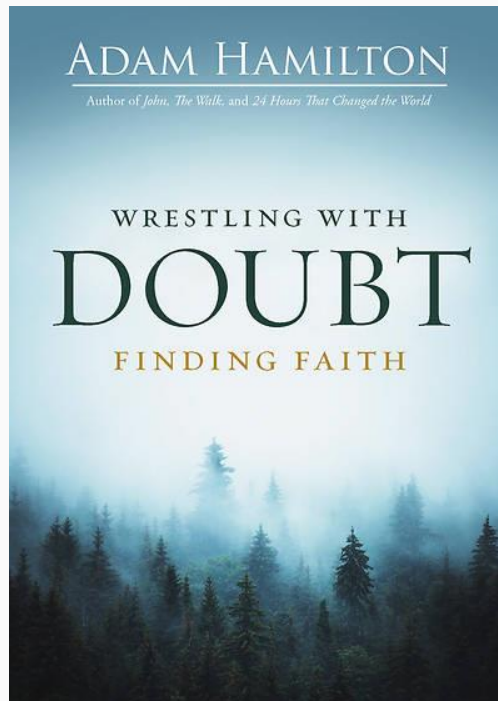
We meet at 10 am in the Love Conference Room each Sunday.
