

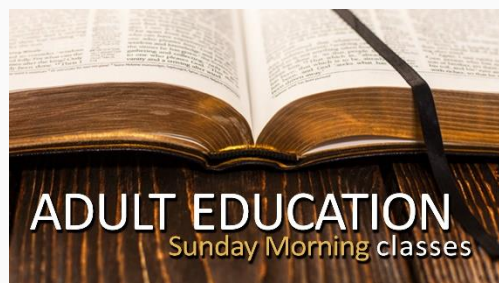

Volunteer are always needed!

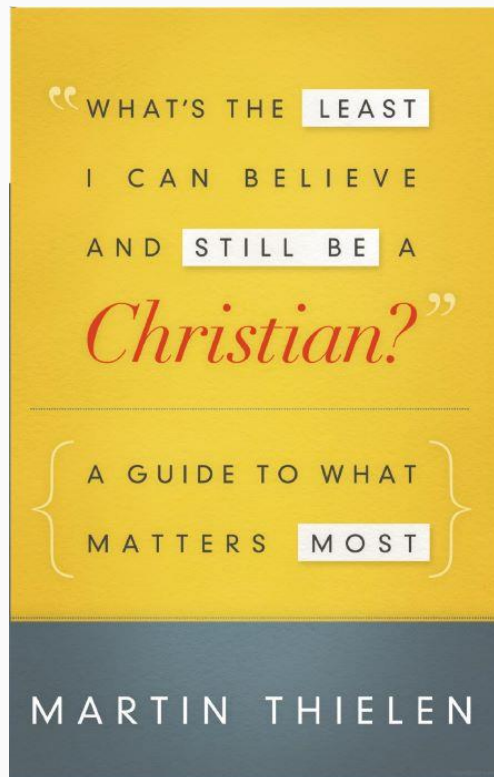

If you would like to make a monetary donation, make a check to the church with the notation: **ABCCM North** (for food) **ABCCM Other** (for all other services/necessities)

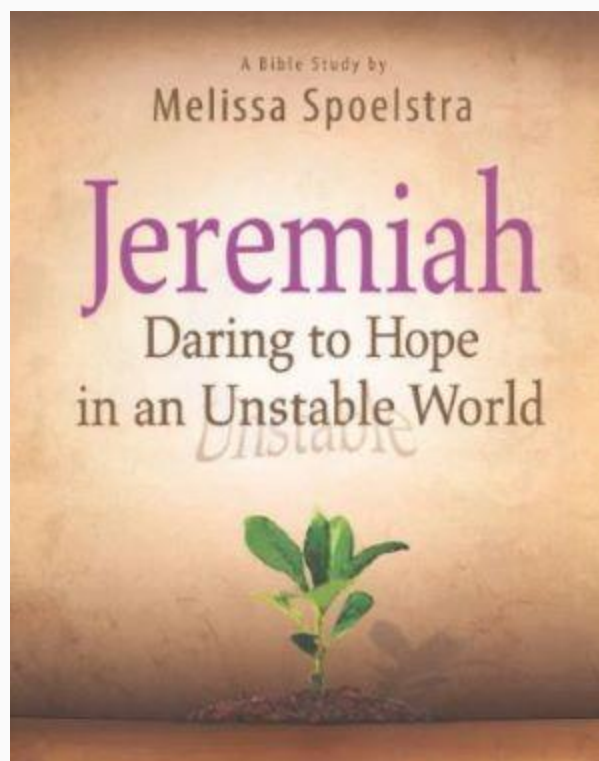


Explorers Class



We meet at 10 am in the Love Conference Room each Sunday. We are studying *What's The Least I can Believe and Still Be a Christian?* by Martin Thielen.

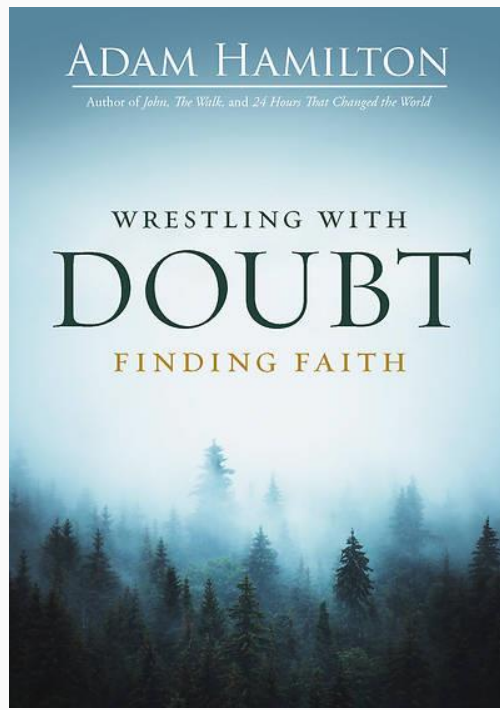
Women's Bible Study
