There is a basket in the Narthex for food donations.

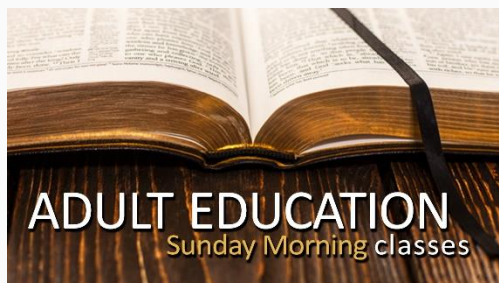

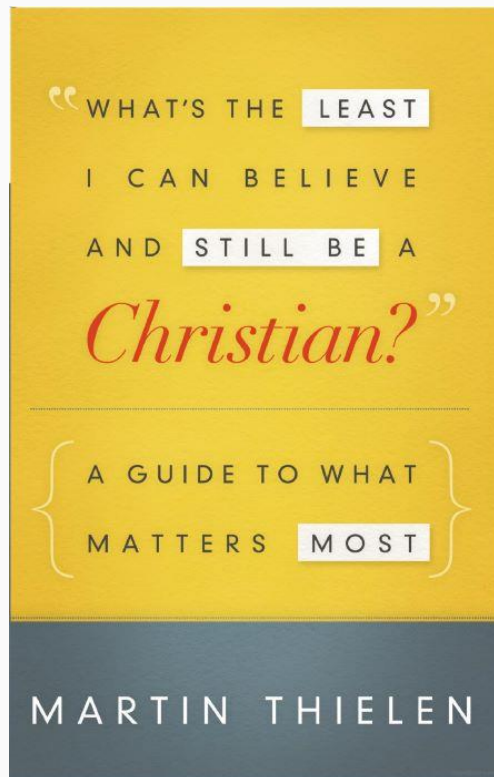

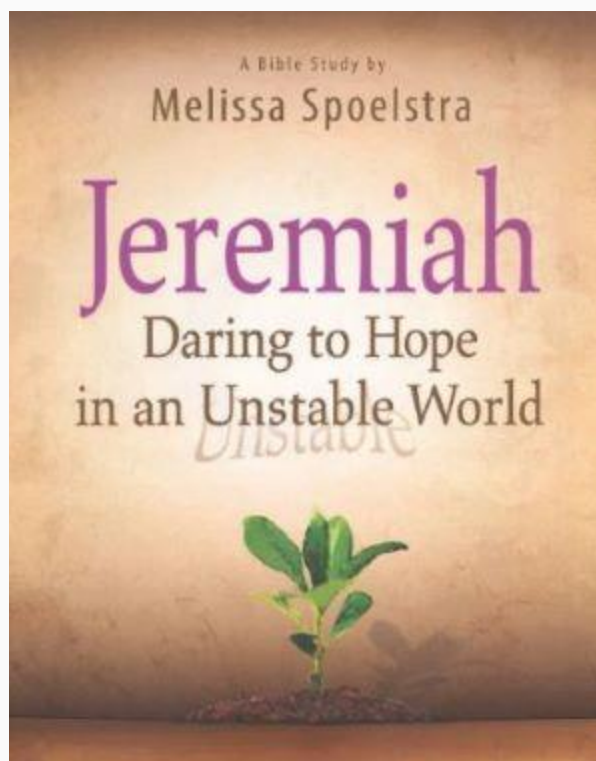


Explorers Class

Martin Thielen.

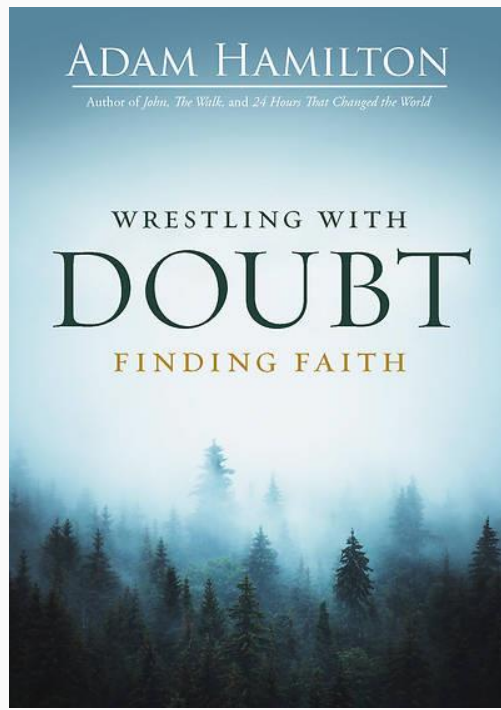
Women's Bible Study
