

There is a basket in the Narthex for food donations.

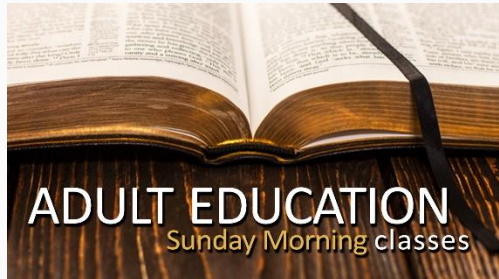

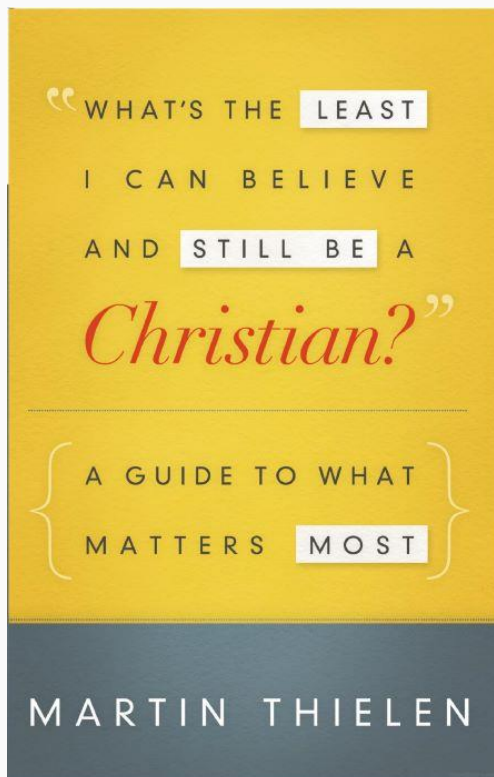

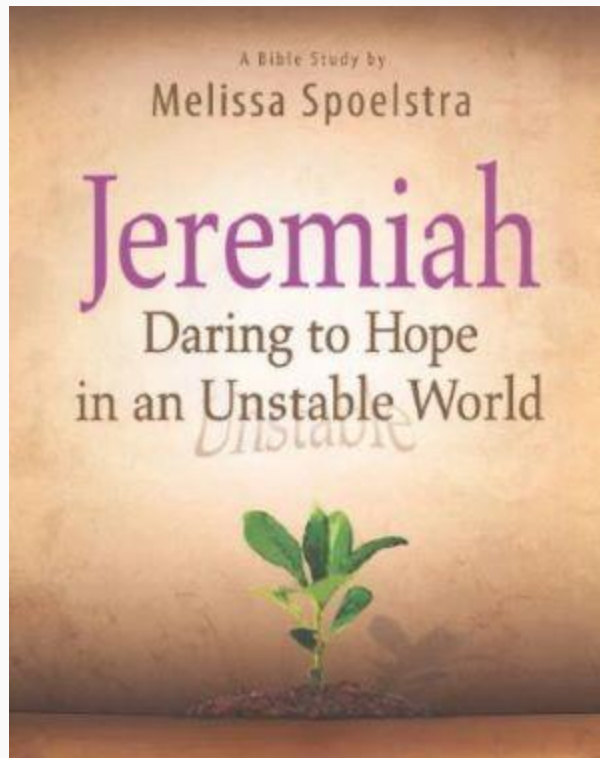


Explorers Class

We are studying *What's The Least I can Believe and Still Be a Christian?* by Martin Thielen.

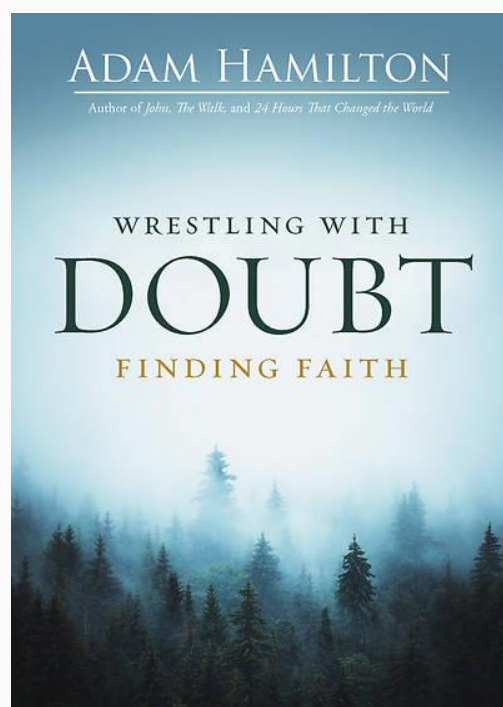
Women's Bible Study
