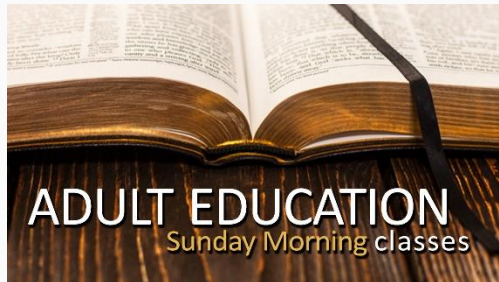
Sewing Bee

Join us for our next sewing bee!

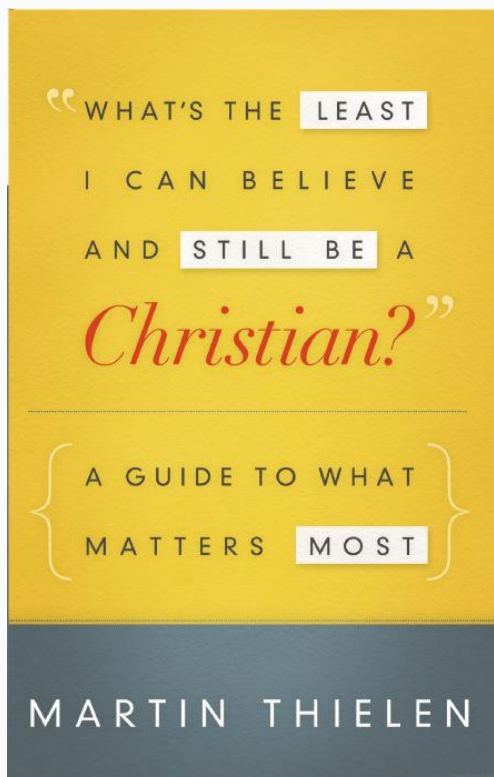
Saturday, June 8, 9:00am - 5:00pm
