FOOD DRIVE FEBRUARY!

For the remaining 3 weeks in February we're setting a goal to collect at least 300 lbs of food for ABCCM!

Thankfully, following the hurricane, generous donations came in from out of the area, local Churches and the local community.

These were especially important and now depleted as the Federal Assistance crisis program (TEFAP) was unable to bring the WNC area's biweekly allotment of meats, milk, cheeses, and canned goods into Manna.

Manna - destroyed by the flooding - receives, stores, and distributes the food to 16 counties and over 200 crisis pantries.

Now that Manna is again up and running, the program will be resuming.

The pantry itself is stocked by donation, and provides staples and items not provided by the Assistance program (which sends a random assortment of items).

Please bring bags to the front pews of the church the next 2 Sundays, and anytime during Church office hours. M,W,F. 9am - 12pm, Thursday, 12pm - 3pm!






Sunday School meets Sunday mornings at 9:45am upstairs in the Education Building.

Explorers Class


The class meets every Sunday in the Education Building, main floor at 10 am. Beginning on Sunday, January 26, we will start Everything Must Change by Brian McLaren.

Ignite Class


