


Youth Group meets Sunday afternoon from 4:30pm-6pm. Bring your bible and a friend. Snacks are provided.

Explorers Class


The class meets every Sunday in the Education Building, main floor at 10 am. The current study is *Everything Must Change* by Brian McLaren.


study & if you haven't joined a Sunday school class or other Bible study in the church, you are welcome to join our Tuesday morning study. Bring a friend or neighbor along.
