Hello from the Preschool and Happy Spring!

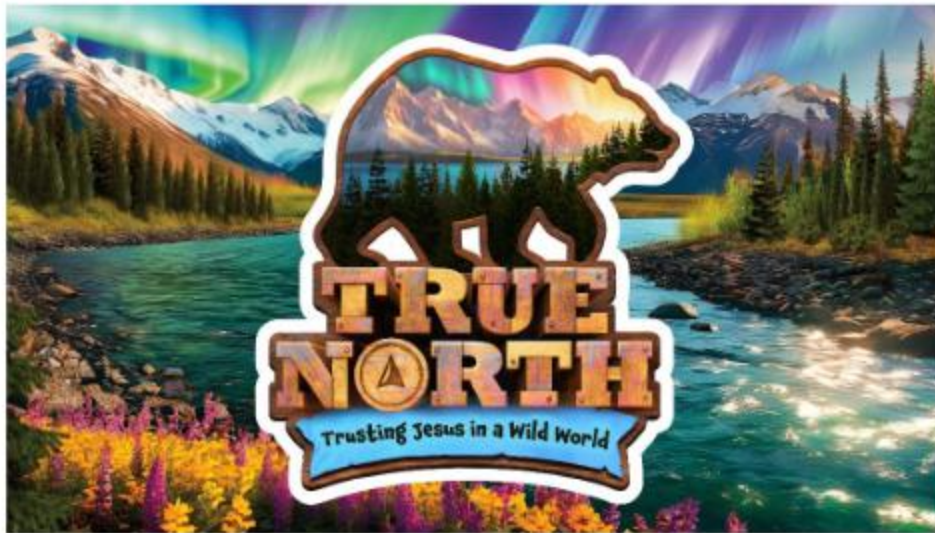

Join us for our next sewing bee Saturday, May 3.

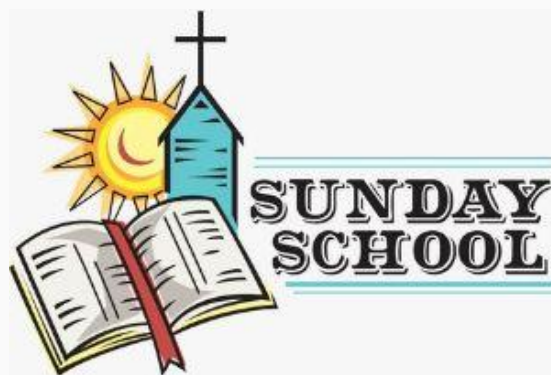

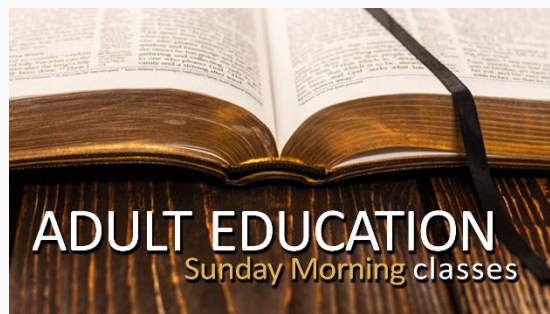

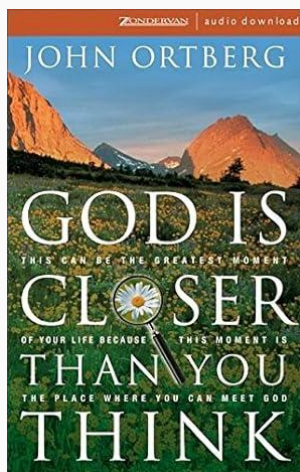
Children's Sunday school meets from 9:45am to 10:45am each Sunday upstairs in the Education Building.

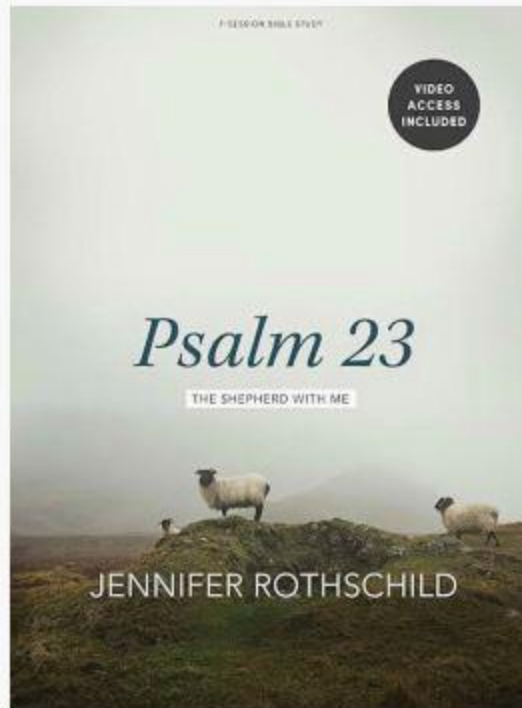
