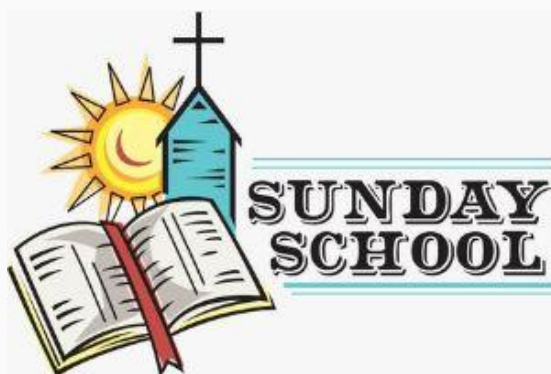

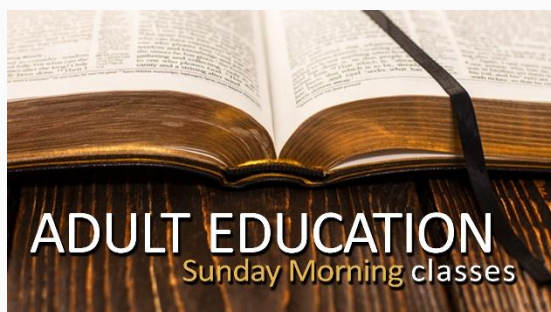
Current Needs: Hearty canned soups, adult cold cereal, ma'n cheese, jelly, rice.

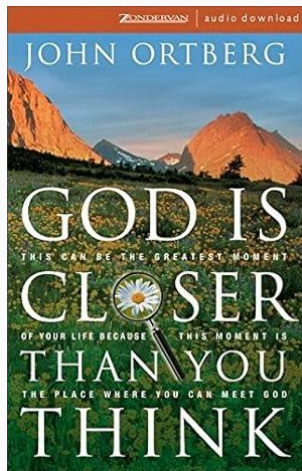
Children's Sunday school meets from 9:45am to 10:45am each Sunday upstairs in the Education Building.

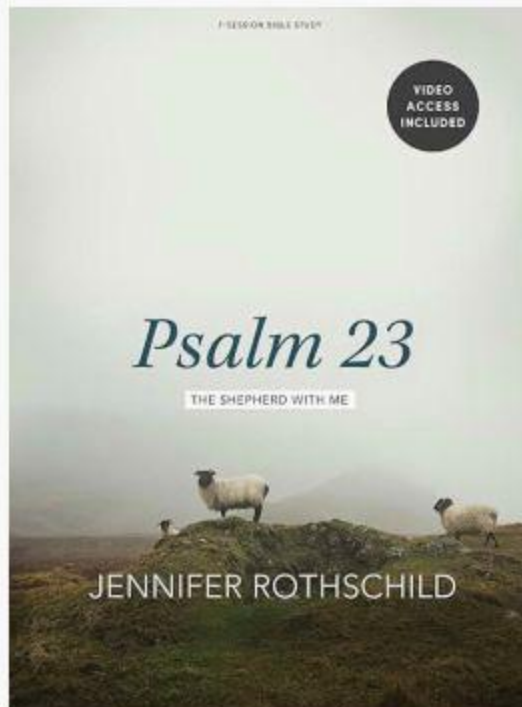
