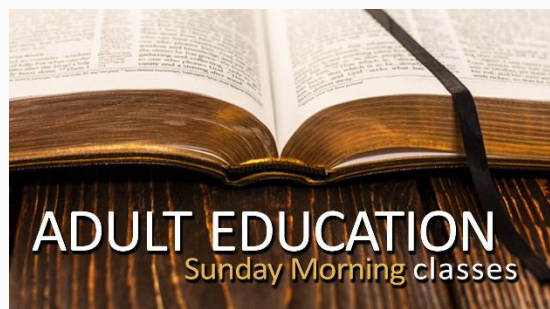
Thanks for keeping others in mind while filling your grocery cart!!

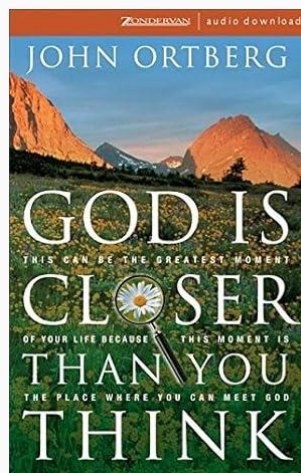


Children's Sunday School is meeting this Sunday at 9:45am in the Education Building.
