
Youth Rafting on the Nantahala Saturday, September 6th!


These items always need replenishing: canned chicken and tuna, hearty soups, adult cold cereal, mac'n cheese.

4:30 Monday through Friday.


Thanks for keeping others in mind while filling your grocery cart!! It's probably the easiest way to help struggling local families in this strained economy.

Ignite Class


The Ignite Class will resume our study on Sunday, September 7, at 9:45 am in the Education Building Room 302.
