Cause


The stairwell to the balcony is closed due to water damage in the ceiling.

Effect

We will not have amplified sound, streaming, or be able to record our worship service until repairs are made.

The stairwell to the balcony is closed until further notice. Upon the restoration of water damage it was discovered that the ceiling beams and boards above the drywall are water damaged, rotted, and sitting on the drywall. The stairwell is not safe and as a result the stairwell is off limits. We are reaching out to contractors and hope to have the issue corrected in the next two weeks. That means we will not be able to access the sound board or the video equipment in the balcony for at least the next two weeks. I hope it will be fixed much sooner so we can resume our streaming service.

School. We have an amazing team of dedicated leaders who are ready to teach and care for your child(ren).






Not just help for a day, but for life.

Thanks for keeping others in mind while filling your grocery cart!!


It's probably the easiest way to help struggling local families in this strained economy.

The Ignite Class will resume our study on Sunday, September 7, at 10 am in the Wesley Brown Room.


