Did you enjoy the church devotions during Advent? Did you miss out on an opportunity to write a devotion?

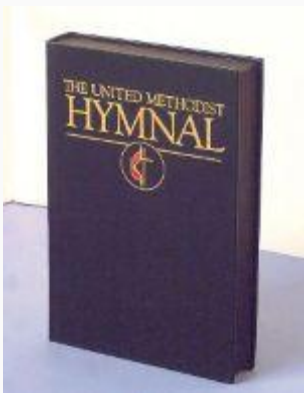

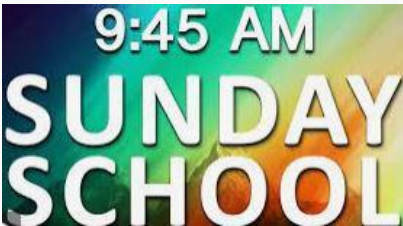

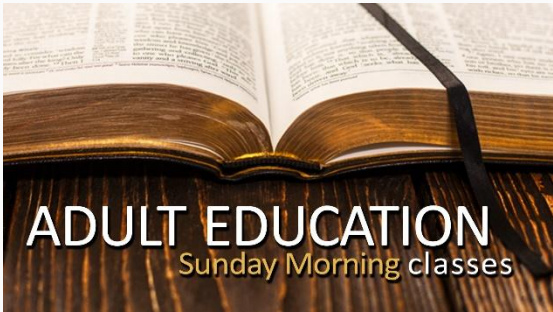

Ignite Class

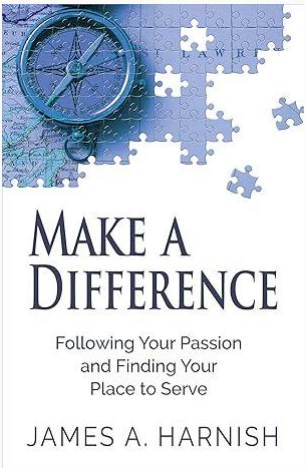

Explorers Class

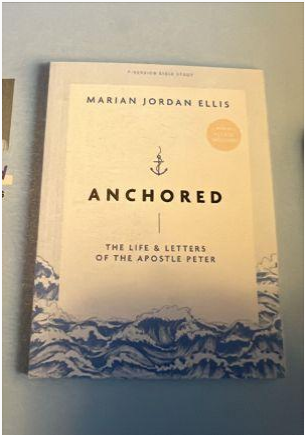
