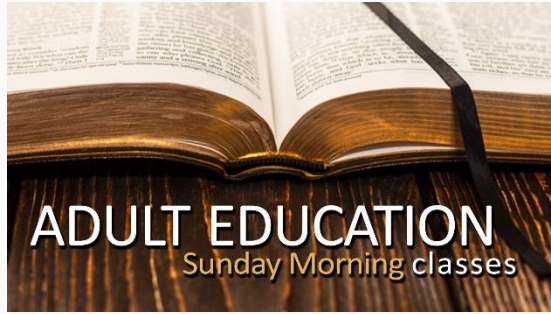

Ignite Class

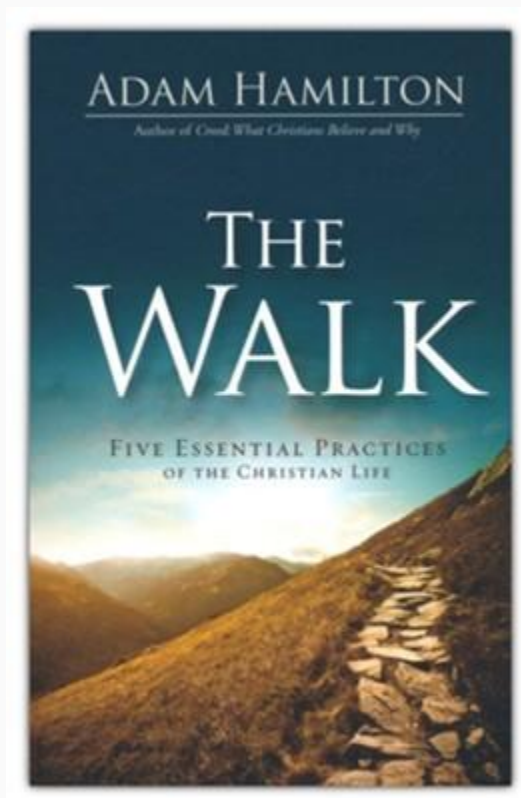

Explorers Class

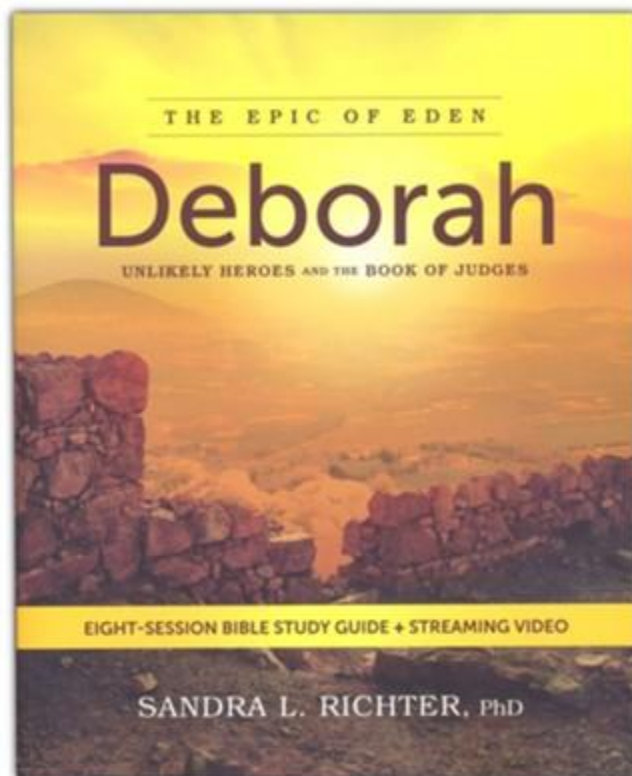
Explorer Class will not meet Easter Sunday but will resume on April 12th at 10am in the Love Conference Room. The current study is The Walk by Adam Hamilton.
